Pressure Drop is a Melbourne reggae-dub band, and one of the early pioneers of rock steady, reggae and dub in Australia starting life in 1978.

As reggae caught on in Australia, the band offered a new sound to the dance and soul crowd in Melbourne and filled houses across the city and down the surf coast. By the early 1980s the band was experimenting with live dub using on-stage echo chambers and mixing techniques that were new to the Melbourne scene. Those sounds still sound contemporary today.
